### SCIENCE OF HOT CHOCOLATE

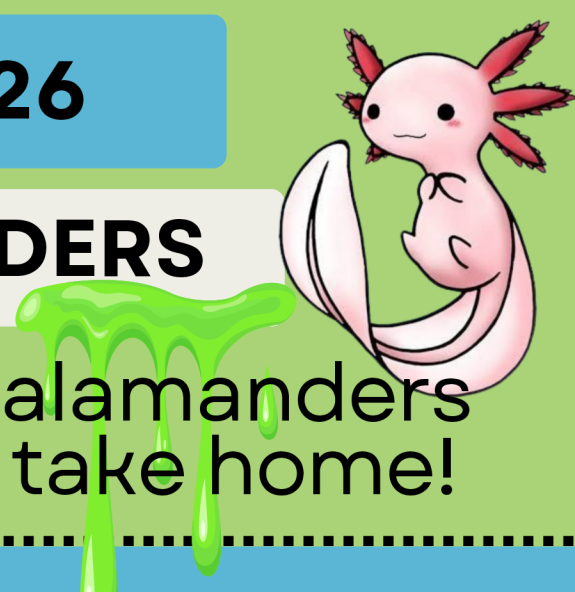
We'll dive into the science behind hot chocolate—from solubility and mixtures to temperature and states of matter. We'll turn your favorite winter treat into a tasty science experiment!
